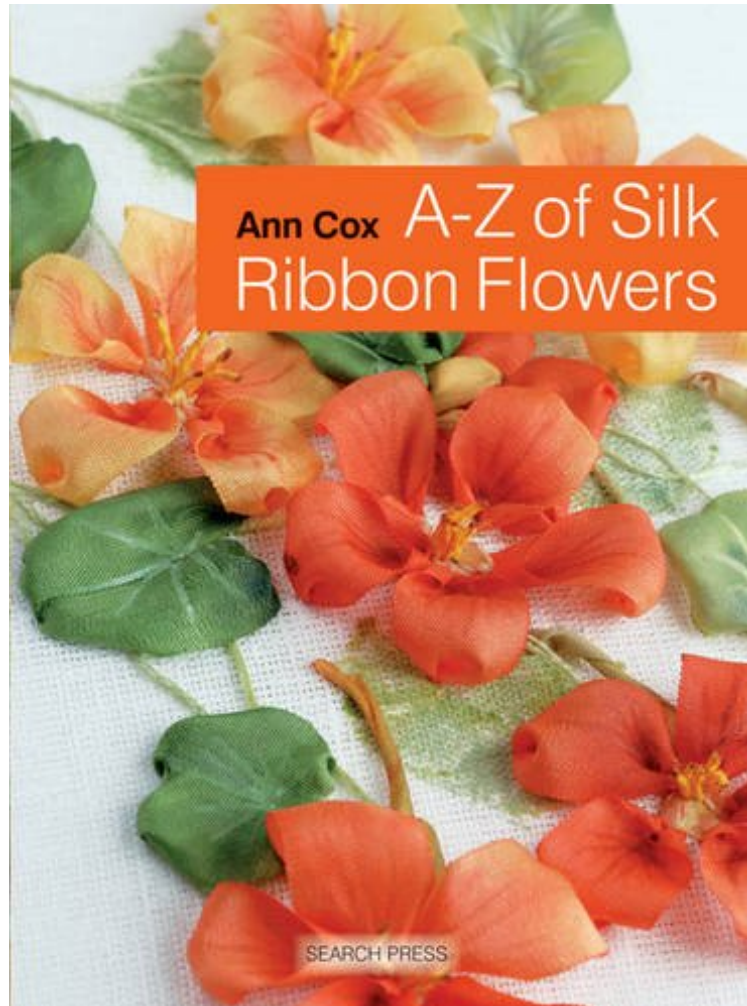

Each project is shown in actual size with a few close-up shots.The instructions are clear and there is plenty of room to express your own creativity and still get beautiful results. My only complaint is that the templates in the book are all half size (or smaller) which means you have to copy them at 200%.
