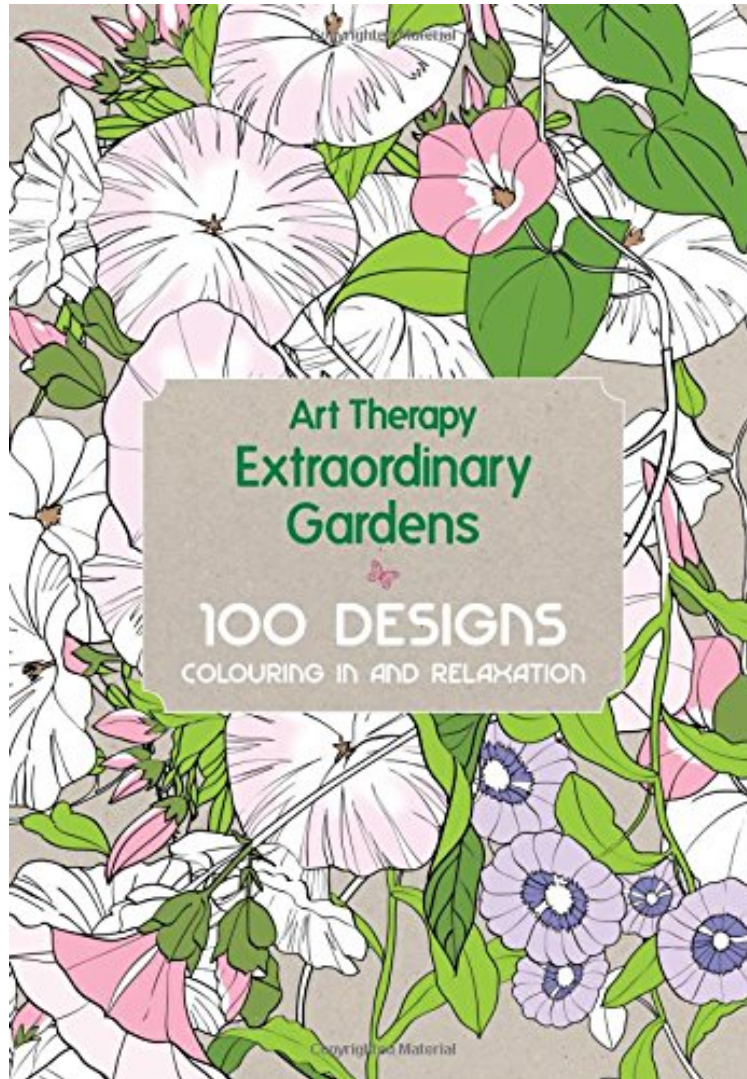

So much nicer than some of our current adult coloring books with their tedious drawings and heavy black lines. The pages of this book do not come out and are printed on

both sides which is usually a reason not to buy for me, but this one is so pretty that I could not resist. It could be a good option to take while traveling with an small assortment of colored pencils so that one can partially complete pages and return to the book once home where a larger number of pencils is available. There are surprisingly some cut-and-paste areas of birds, butterflies, etc. and some pages resemble wall paper in Victorian era homes, but all in all an attractive book of illustrations not usually seen in the US. The only oddity is that the book is listed as hardcover but is actually a paperback with board covers (like baby's first books) glued to the front and back. The title paper glued to those board covers is flimsy and will not last so I may try to find plastic covers for the book so it can withstand handling. The board covers and the cut-and-paste issues keep it from being five stars but if you like traditional drawings, you should enjoy this Art Therapy coloring book.
