Pros: Good illustrations and templates. Good explanations. All in all, I'd say the book is helpful. The flowers won't fool you into thinking they're natural, but they're more realistic than some paper flowers. I consider the book worthwhile as an instruction book.  
Cons: As has been mentioned by several other reviewers, the paper is not the kind discussed in the book. Nor is its texture similar to that of flower petals. I can't see it being satisfactory for making paper flowers at all. I'd opt for getting the book, minus the extras. There are good tips in the book. Too bad the kit didn't supply the proper materials to go with them.
