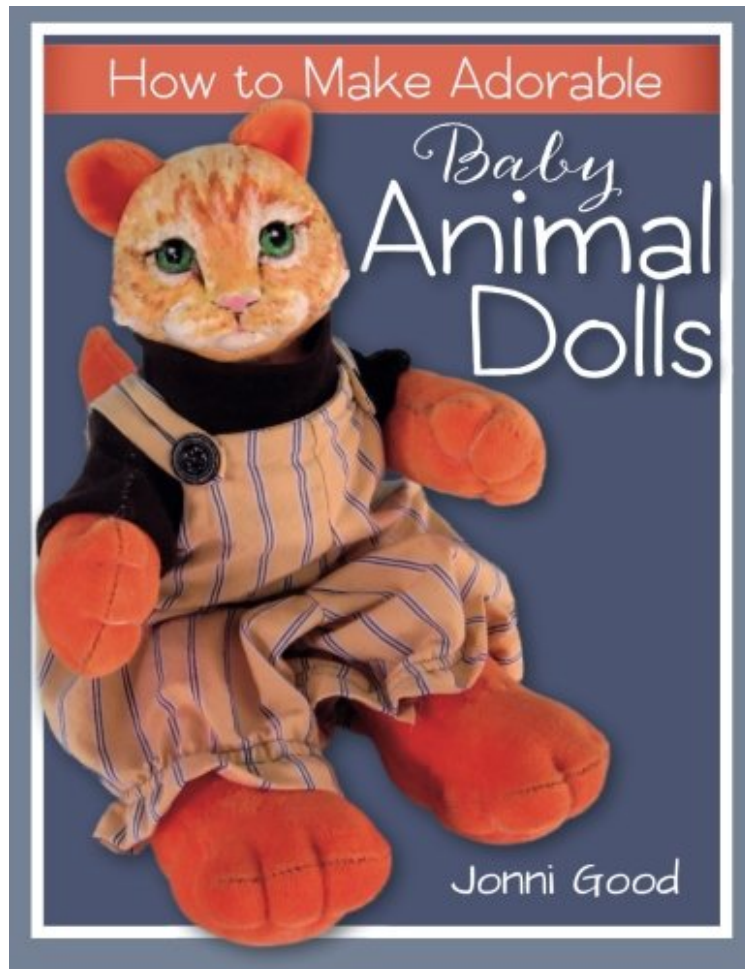

I just love Jonni and everything she does. Her website is one of my absolute favorites, and when she wrote of this new book coming out, I could hardly wait. The Animal Dolls are just as described in the title- adorable. She is the best thing that has happened to paper mache.

In this book the author shows you exactly how to make adorable baby animal dolls, leading you through the entire process every step of the way. Your dolls wont cost much to make, and every doll will be an original, one-of-a-kind work of art. Since no two dolls ever come out exactly alike, each doll will have its own personality and character. You wont have to learn how to make molds for the doll heads, because each one is hand-sculpted over a simple armature. You dont need a kiln, because youll be using home-made air-dry clay instead of porcelain. The resulting heads are seamless, hollow, and surprisingly strong. The bodies and ears are made out of soft, huggable cotton velour, and the toes are sculpted with a few easy stitches. Adorable! The dolls in this book are intended for adult collectors or older children, not babies.
