JacqueThe new model rail is often assaulted by books demonstrating how he/she can "easily" wire their model railroad, provided that one has an undergraduate degree in electronics and knows/wants DCC control. Unfortunately, there is currently NOTHING that is geared towards the beginner regarding basic wiring.The late Linn Westcott wrote a very basic book on wiring for model railroads back in the 1950's, a book that was reprinted until the author's death. This is really too bad, as this is THE BOOK every beginning model rail needs. Westcott starts out by demonstrating how to wire for a basic setup, then on to "block control" (where the layout is divided into blocks that have current shut down or kept running, for more realistic control), to wiring an inferior power pack for control of lights, switches, and so on. There is a lot more, but to list and describe everything would defeat the purpose of sales of the book!Thankfully, used copies of this book can still be found on (I have yet to see a copy surface at swap meets or model rail shows, shows how much model rails value this book!).
