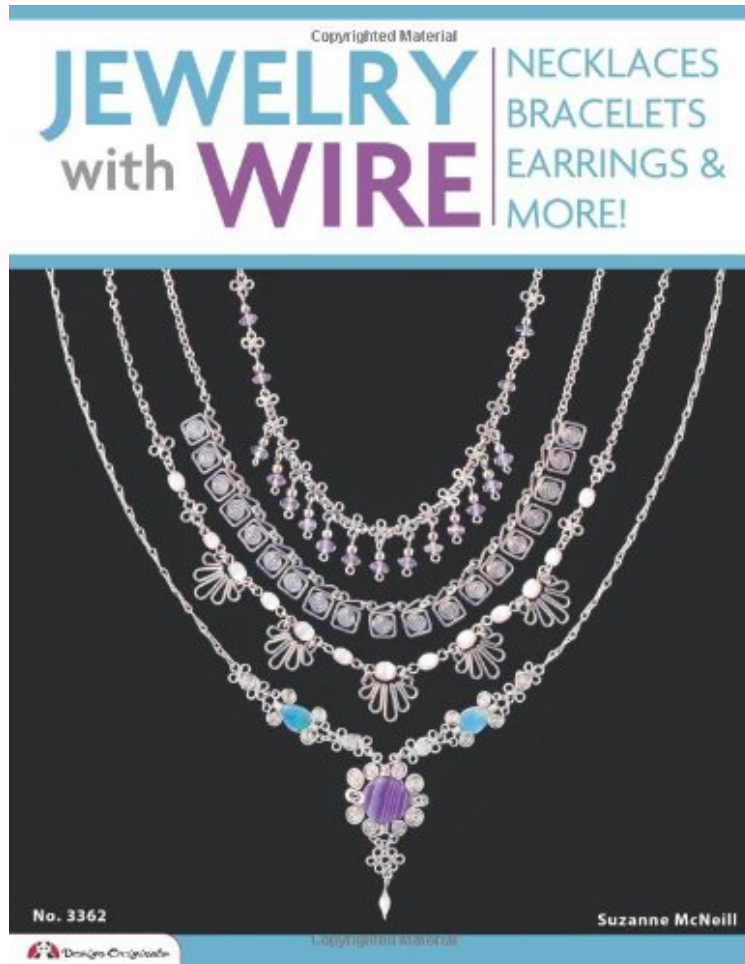

0 of 0 people found the following review helpful. This is a neat book! By H. K. Rodman I'm an experienced wireworker, and I was impressed with this little book. All of the designs are in 20 gauge wire, the most common and usually least-expensive of the larger-gauged wires. I have high standards for wirework components: they have to be strong, they have to not be "grabby" (i.e., not a lot of sticky-outy bits that snag hair, clothing, etc.), they need to be versatile, and they have to be pretty. Almost everything in the book meets those criteria! I was also impressed that everything in the book is made using simple hand tools, too- while you probably could do some of this on a jig, the

author didn't, and I really liked that, since I'm not a "jig-person". There's not a lot of things left to do with wire that haven't already been done; after all, it's an art that dates back to pretty much the beginnings of civilization. This book surprised me, and gave me a fresh perspective, which doesn't happen all that often. I'd recommend it for anyone, new to wirework or an old hand. There's a lot of garbage out there, books that won't teach you anything- this one isn't one of 'em. Give it a whirl!
