This book gives a comprehensive list of who manufactures all the elements for each card, (as most card-making books do); that's fine if you want the EXACT look of the card...I have never used this list, not wanting to go out purchase something when so many substitutions I already have will do just fine. This book does give many useful tips on time money saving as well as how to tweak the appearance of your card or give it a different look from what is pictured. Another nice feature is the section in the back containing the various patterns used throughout the book; that way you can use the sketch outlines for your own creations without getting sidetracked by the fully designed card.
