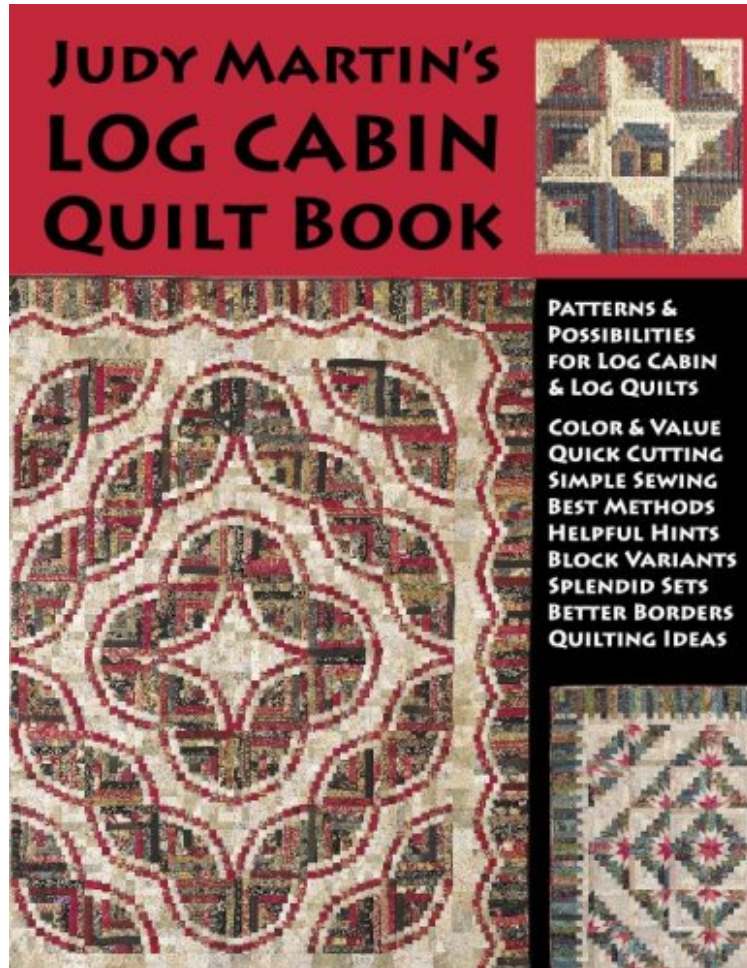

The one problem we had with the book was that the fabric requirements were listed in fat quarters and not at all in yards. So we had to do some math to figure out how much fabric we needed. It also had some trouble areas in certain patterns with not being clear as to what size to cut the blocks/strips. It was not easy to understand for me as a beginning sewer and took my mom who is an expert sewer some thinking to really
