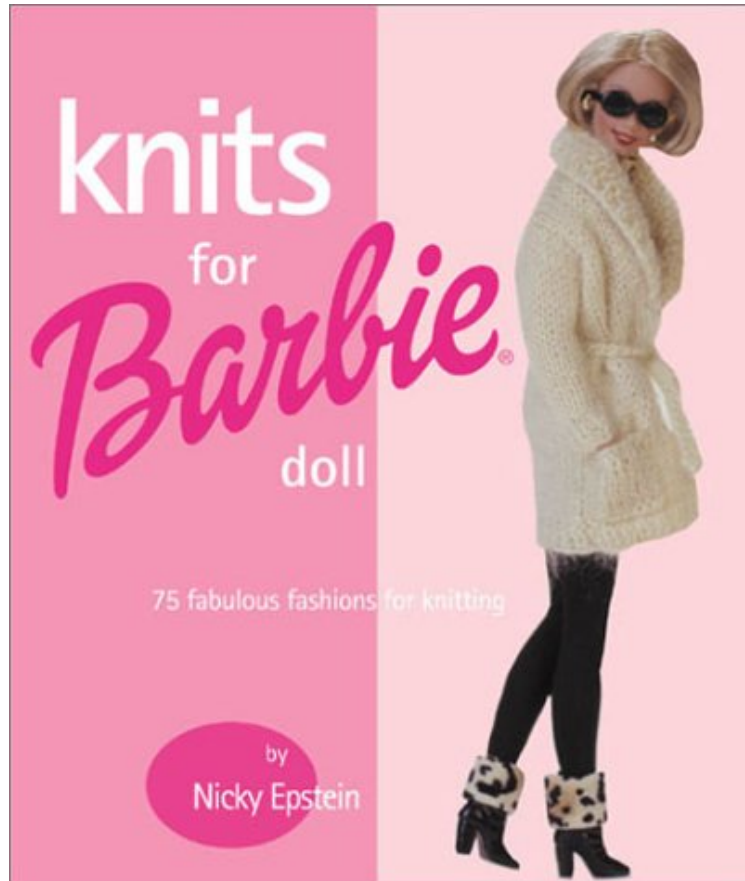

It would have been nice to have added some circular or top down patterns, with 75 patterns there is certainly space for some different constructions.Secondly and more importantly, she NEVER lists the yarn weight - just the brand. I recognized the DMC pearl cotton but most I had no idea. I assume they are quite fine but please don't make me guess! She does list the resources at the end but I want to use yarn I already had.
