I also have knitted the bunnies.. they are beautiful. I loved knitting them and the babies. I have also knitted the mice. They are great too. I have used parts of the doll dress patterns to knit some other items. I love the shaping that Laura Long puts in her books. I love her simple instructions. For the ears of the pig instead of using fabric, I knit them two sided in the round.. (Sort of like knitting it twice) I also did this for the bunnies. It turns out great.. and if you don't have fabric it is easy to do. Fry The book has lots of cute, creative toys with detailed shaping. The knitting instructions are concise and

correct. As others have stated, the assembly instructions are not clear. For example, I wasn't always certain which end of the ear was the base and which was the tip. I made a teddy bear, elephant and bunny for my grandkids. Terrycloth-type yarn is recommended for the bunny. I've never used that type of yarn and it was more difficult for me to work with, but the pattern was simple and the bunny turned out quite nice. I haven't knit for more than 20 years, but I was able to follow the directions without difficulty. I even modified the directions a bit, knitting the projects on double-pointed needles to eliminate having a seam. 0 of 0 people found the following review helpful.
